B. Denmark's higher education performance in U-Multirank

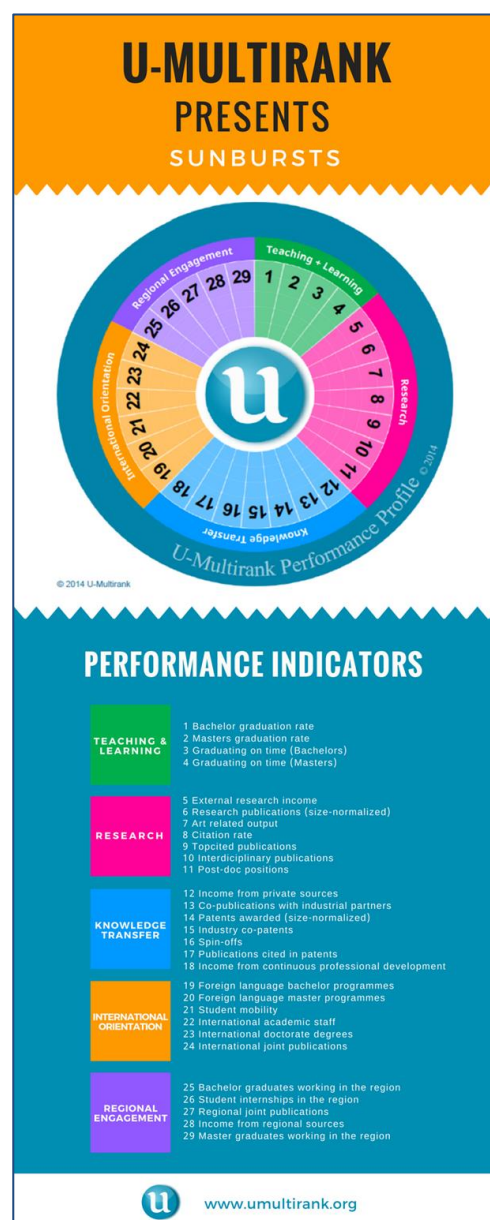
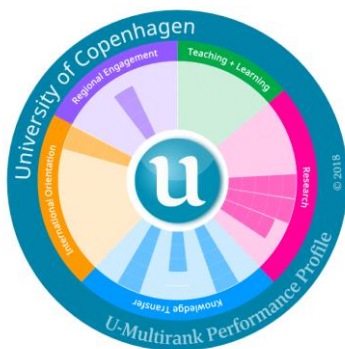
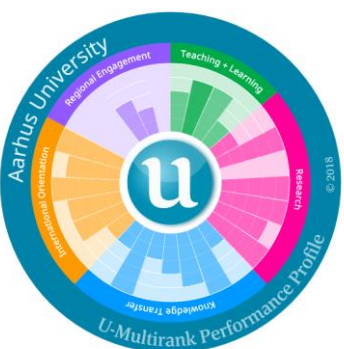
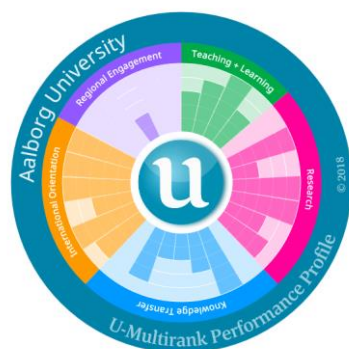
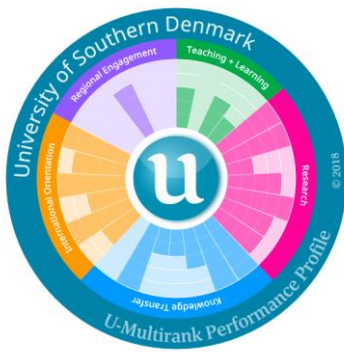
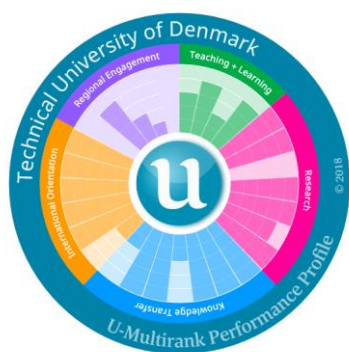


1. In a global perspective, the higher education institutions in Denmark perform strongest in U-Multirank's Teaching and Learning, International Orientation as well as Research dimensions.
2. The Danish institutions with the highest number of overall top scores are the Technical University of Denmark (16), Aalborg University (9), the University of Southern Denmark (9) and Aarhus University (8) and University of Copenhagen (7).
3. The Technical University of Denmark achieved all its top scores in the three dimensions: Research (5), Knowledge Transfer (6) and International Orientation (5).
4. Six out of eight Danish universities in U-Multirank excel in Co-publications with Industrial Partners.

C. Universities with the highest number of overall top scores

In this section we highlight the five universities receiving the highest number of 'A' (very good) scores on the institutional level for the respective country (*in the event of ties, more universities will be shown*). **Using our unique sunburst chart, a clear picture is shown of the university's overall performance (the longer the bar, the higher the score).** Although the number of 'A' scores shows top performance for the respective university, it does not imply one university is the 'best' in the country, as each university profile highlights different strengths. 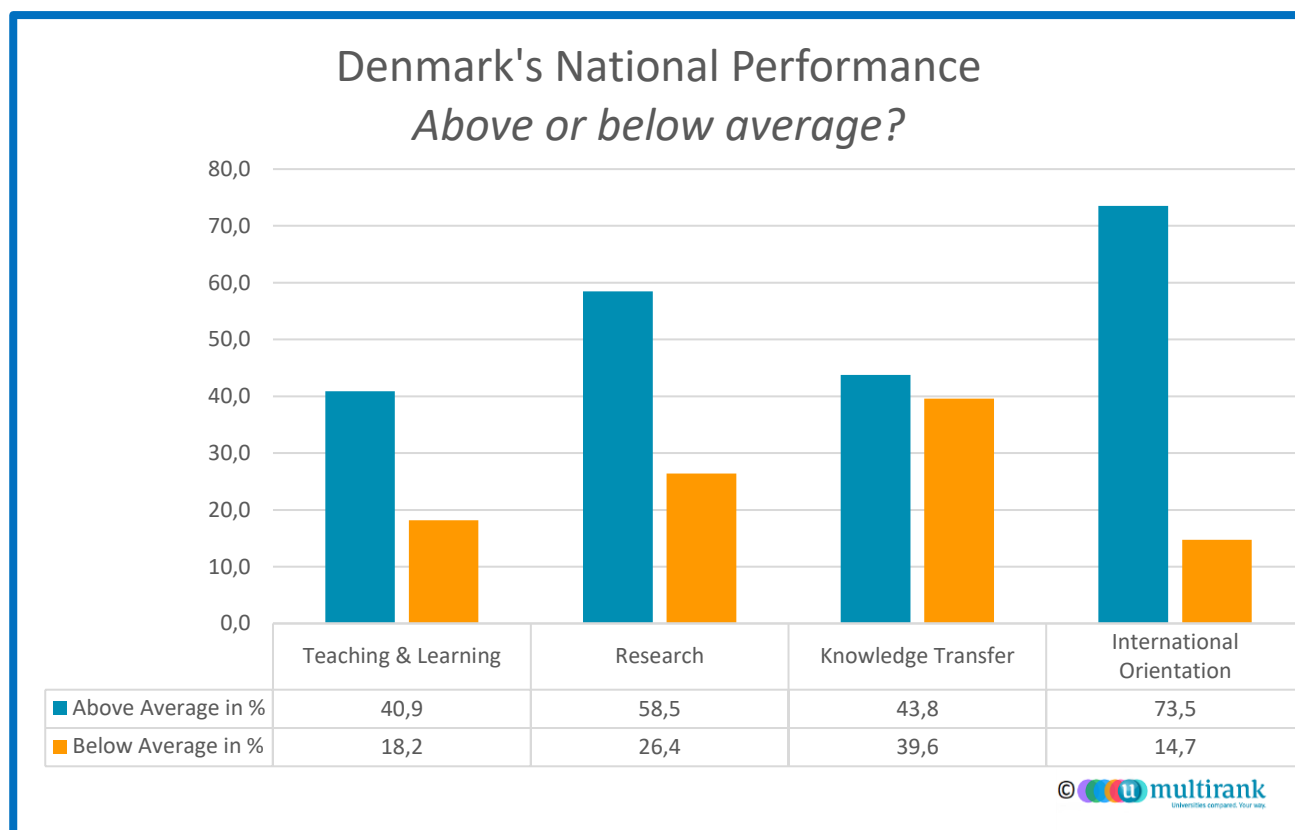

D. National performance: above or below average?

In this section we highlight the overall performance of Danish universities on the institutional level per U-Multirank dimension. The below table shows the national breakdown of Danish universities and how they stand across the spectrum of above average (receiving a score of 'A' (very good) or 'B' (good)), or below average (receiving a score of 'D' (below average) or 'E' (weak)). In doing so, U-Multirank offers a clear picture on the countries strengths, and areas for improvement.
